





01 | 2019/2020 Giving Campaign Update

Thank you to all of you who have donated so far. It's not too late to contribute and to help us reach our goal to fund all of the great Highland programs this year!

- Giving Campaign Donations = \$52,045 of \$55,000 GOAL = 94%
- School Supply Donations = \$9,680 of \$11,760 GOAL = 82%
- 4th & 5th Grade Bootcamp Donations = \$7,748 of \$8,192 = 94%

We ARE AT 93% to fully fund the PTO Budget this year!
