Thank you to all of you who have donated so far. It's not too late to contribute and help us reach our goal to fund all of the great Highland programs this year!

- Giving Campaign Donations = \$38,091 of \$55,000 GOAL = 70%
- School Supply Donations = \$8,260 of \$11,760 GOAL = 70%
- 4th & 5th Grade Bootcamp Donations = \$6,409 of \$8,192 = 78%
