JJ Howard : January Content Speaker

- Siberia Storyline Conference (March 2020)
 - > Storyline conferences have been held for over 15 years
 - > Siberia Conference: 6 people from the West Coast. Presenters from Scotland, England, Slovenia, Iceland, Germany, Russia, and USA.
 - > JJ is working with a Portland based storyline educator to deliver a ½ day Introduction to Storyline (based on a 7 day course) at the Siberia conference. JJ will also be presenting on All School Storylines.
 - Next International Storyline Conference will be in March 2021 over Spring Break in Sweden

- > Are the conferences open to everyone? Yes, everyone is welcome to participate.
- > Highland is the only elementary school in the US that is storyline K-5. It's pretty powerful/magical when teachers around the world ask us about our experiences.

- Sally (one of the founders of Storyline) called Highland the "beacon of storyline".
- > Several hundred people attend these conferences (e.g., about 300 in Slovenia, more in Portland).
